Living natural gas-free in Middenmeer

The first step

The Netherlands is replacing gas-based heating with carbon-free heating. Amsterdam aims to be a natural gas-free city by 2040. In the Middenmeer district in Watergraafsmeer, we can use residual heat from a data center at the Amsterdam Science Park to heat our own neighbourhood. In the future, we can use this local energy source to sustainably heat our homes and tap water and become independent of commercial energy suppliers. By signing this start contract, you support the development of the heat network and choose to heat your home with residual heat in the future.



Local cooperative MeerEnergie

The heat network is an initiative of the local cooperative MeerEnergie. MeerEnergie collaborates with the Municipality of Amsterdam and infrastructure specialist Firan in developing this heat network. MeerEnergie belongs to its members; it is a not-for-profit organisation and aims to provide a fair, transparent and affordable alternative to natural gas for all local residents. MeerEnergie is planning to start a heating company in collaboration with Firan.

If you sign this start contract, you agree to sign a connection and supply agreement once the heat network is in operation, unless the rules on cancellation apply. In that case, the start contract will be no longer valid. Once the heat network is installed, MeerEnergie will connect your home to the heat network by installing a heat exchanger, and heating pipes will be laid inside your home leading to the unit. After that, the heat network will provide you with hot tap water and heating.

What are you signing?

By signing this start contract, you declare that you will sign the connection and supply agreement as soon as the heat network is in operation. The draft version of the documents that apply to the connection and supply of heat can be found on the website. If you prefer a paper version, please let us know.

By signing this start contract, you automatically become a member of the local cooperative MeerEnergie. As a member of MeerEnergie, you have voting rights in the General Members Assembly. The final connection and supply agreements will be available three months before the start of the construction of the heat network.

Rules on cancellation

Homeowners, tenants and landlords can rely on the following rules on cancellation:

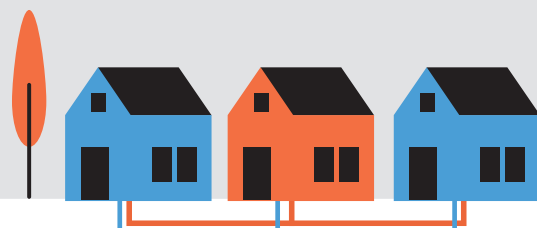
1. If the monthly costs at the start of the heat supply from district heating are higher than the prevailing rates for alternatives in your situation, for example central heating boiler or all-electric heat pump. This applies to the monthly variable and fixed costs and only for legally and practically possible alternatives;
2. If the landlord, homeowners' association (VvE) or tenant, other than the signatory, does not agree to sign the connection and supply agreement (for example, if the tenant has signed the start contract, but the landlord does not want to sign the connection and supply agreement, or if a homeowner has signed a start contract, but the VvE does not agree);
3. If the property is sold before signing the connection and supply agreement.

What to expect as a homeowner or landlord?

- Reliable connection and supply of sustainable, affordable heat as soon as the heat network is in operation;
- If your boiler needs replacement between signing the start contract and connecting to the heat network (probably between 2028 - 2035), MeerEnergie will assist with a joint solution with a rental or second-hand boiler in collaboration with a partner;
- Opportunity to participate in a joint purchasing action for induction cooktops;
- Contribution towards modifications to your fuse board (up to €100). In some of the homes, this modification is necessary to install an induction cooktop;
- Selling your home? The new owner will receive the same conditions as you (if they want to).

What to expect as a tenant?

- Reliable supply of sustainable, affordable heat as soon as the heat network is in operation;
- MeerEnergie will arrange everything needed for the connection with your landlord.



Rates

The heating company plans to install the district heating between 2028 and 2035. Not everyone will be connected to the grid at the same time. MeerEnergie ensures that residents can prepare themselves well in time. The heat rate for the calendar year in question will be determined no later than three months before the first homes are connected.

Monthly costs

The monthly rates for the heat network are based on what is needed to keep the heating company running smoothly and on comparable costs that residents would have on average for other heating systems, such as a central heating boiler or an all-electric heat pump.

The Netherlands Authority for Consumers and Markets (ACM), which represents the interests of consumers, also sets a maximum for heat rates for district heating.

Adjustments for electric cooking

When starting the heat supply, the heating company charges a one-off contribution to the connection costs.

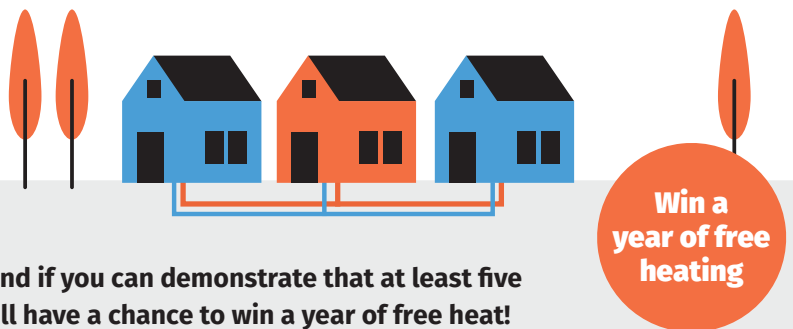
For rented homes, the one-off contribution to the connection costs is normally paid by the landlord. Home or property owners, landlords and tenants will receive individual benefits if they sign before 31st of January 2025.

Benefit if you sign the starter contract before May 1, 2025.

10% discount

- Homeowners and landlords: 10% discount on the net contribution to the connection costs of the heat network.
- Tenants: 10% discount on the costs of variable heat consumption in the first year after connection.

Offer extended



If you sign the start contract before May 1, 2025, and if you can demonstrate that at least five other neighbours also sign because of you, you will have a chance to win a year of free heat!

This applies to individual signatories including so-called 'straataanvoerders', excl. board members, VvEs or landlords with multiple homes for rent.
